



Dear Parents/Legal Guardian,

SAFETY TOWN is offered to any child entering 5 year old Kindergarten in fall of 2017. When your child enters Kindergarten this fall, he or she will encounter many new experiences. We cannot trust our child's life to a few memorized "do's and don'ts" taught in the home....our world has become too complex for that type of learning alone.

SAFETY TOWN the important first step in our children's safety education. Safety Town is an organized aide for preparing our children to cope with and understand ever-increasing safety hazards.

Children must be safety minded, and that is why **SAFETY TOWN** is being sponsored by the Burlington Jaycees. We believe in the children of Burlington.

SAFETY TOWN is an early childhood safety education program designed to introduce all types of safety conditions to preschool children. During a 15 hour course (1.5 hours a day for 2 weeks), children will learn safety behavior through their own involvement. They do this under the guidance/instruction of a licensed teacher, police officers, and student volunteer instructors. A miniature layout of town is built to the scale of the pre-school child. Safety lessons are taught with the child learning through actual demonstrations and participation.

Movies, songs posters, bus trips, and field trips to the Burlington Police and Burlington Fire Departments are several of the things that your child will be experiencing. This program is a fun learning experience that children eagerly look forward to attending.

After the course, each child should be familiar with the following:

1. Separation from parent
2. Name, address and telephone number
3. Identifying their house and surroundings
4. Proper street crossing
5. Importance of using a crosswalk
6. Stopping at a curb
7. Crossing streets using a traffic light and walk light
8. Dangers of walking between parked cars
9. Walking where there are no sidewalks
10. Dangers of trains and proper procedure when crossing railroad tracks
11. Dangers of chasing a ball into the street
12. Colors, shapes and meaning of safety signs
13. Safe places to play
14. Bus procedure
15. Proper way to enter and exit a car on curb side
16. Importance of safety belts
17. Dangers of household objects, medicine bottles, etc.
18. Strangers and what to do if approached by a stranger
19. Bicycle, tricycle and pedal car safety
20. The importance of the buddy system
21. What to do if lost
22. What to do in case of fire
23. Dangers of matches, lighters and fire
24. Emergency vehicles and what they do
25. The importance of thinking safely

Parents are encouraged to attend the last 5 -10 minutes of class and learn what was taught to further encourage safe behaviors at home. There will also be an opportunity to participate in parent activities (example: car seat checks, etc...)
